INSTITUTE FOR POPULATION HEALTH ServSafe MANAGEMENT CERTIFICATION COURSE

SCOPE OF SERVICE:

The Institute for Population health (IPH) administers a nationally approved and accredited food safety management certification course for local food service businesses that seek to have a member of their staff trained on the principles of food sanitation and safety. IPH is the agency that provides inspections and licensing for all food service establishments in Detroit. Our highly trained instructor/proctor has over 25 years of experience in food sanitation. During this two day class participants will learn principles of food safety and food service management systems. Attendees will acquire the necessary skills to train food handlers as required by Michigan Food Law. The certification is through the Education Fountain of the National Restaurant Association and is valid for 5 years. Attendees who pass the course should receive their ServSafe certificates in approximately two weeks from date of exam. IPH will conduct Post certification courses as the need arises.

PROGRAM DESIGN:

In accordance with the Educational Foundation of the National Restaurant Association (NRA) standards, the Institute for Population Health's (IPH) Food Safety program provides a two (2) day training class to registered students. Upon completion of the course, each participant will be allotted two (2) hours at the conclusion for testing. A certified proctor(s) administers the exam. The ServSafe exam consists of 90 questions and testers must receive a 75 percent score or better to pass this test and receive their Food Safety Certificate. For individuals with documentation that they have completed an approved on-line training course, a certified proctor will administer the exam. Cost for exam only is \$100.00

PROGRAM FREQUENCY:

IPH offers the management certification course on a quarterly basis. As the demand for more classes arise, additional classes will be added to the training schedule.

PROGRAM COST:

The cost for the educational course is \$175.00, which includes the textbook and the proctored examination.

LOCATION AND PROGRAM CAPACITY: Classes are conveniently looked in downtown Detroit at **IPH Riverfront location 1400 Woodbridge, Detroit, Michigan.** Free parking is available.
