<p><b>General Summary of Function/Purpose of Position</b></p> <p><b>Assessment:</b> Obtain a comprehensive health history including reproductive health, and sexual behaviors. Performs psychosocial evaluation, age-appropriate screenings (developmental), oral health, nutrition, lifestyle, risk, mental health, acute pain, chronic pain assessments, and a comprehensive physical exam.</p> <p><b>Diagnosis:</b> Formulate a diagnosis, perform and order diagnostic tests, and interprets results from diagnostic test. Consult with the Medical Director, Physician, or Specialty Physician as indicated.</p> <p><b>Clinical Management:</b> Care for acute and chronic illness, minor injuries, prescribes medications, prescribes non-pharmacologic interventions, manages health promotion interventions, immunizations based on current recommendations, performs primary care procedures such as wart removal, and suturing.</p> <p><b>Evaluates:</b> The treatment plan, staff performance, fosters collaboration, serves as the medical resource person for medical care, maintains a Collaborative Practice Agreement with a Physician, and bills for services according to the level of care. Precepts students, novice nurse practitioners, and/other health professionals. Participates in quality improvement activities and peer review record audits.</p>
