The Institute for Population Health (IPH) Maternal Infant Health Program(MIHP)provides supportive services to pregnant women and families with infants from birth to age one.

The services are provided in the home by a team of nurses, nutritionists, and social workers. Services can be provided in other locations as needed.

MIHP services are provided at no cost to residents of the City of Detroit & surrounding communities.

Medicaid pays for MIHP services to qualified pregnant women and infants.

- To reduce the number of premature and low birth weight births.
- To reduce the number of infant deaths
- To help pregnant and parenting women get care and support

IPH's MIHP specializes in assisting families with needs and concern such as:

- Missed health care appointments due to lack of transportation
- No health care provider
- Mother under age 18
- Learning more about parenting and/or infant growth and development
- Support to decrease isolation, depression, or stress
- Excessive or low weight gain of mother and/or infant
- Cigarette, alcohol, or drug use/abuse
- Prior premature or low birth weight baby
- Living in an unsafe situation
- Mental or physical health concerns
- Current or past physical, emotional, or sexual abuse
- Resources for low income-housing
- Medicaid insurance enrollment
