



Notice for FTCA Deemed Health Centers

The Institute for Population Health, Inc. (IPH) is a Health Center Program that receives grant funding under 42 U.S.C. 254b, and has been deemed a Public Health Service employee for purposes of certain liability protections, including Federal Tort Claims Act coverage, under 42 U.S.C. 233(g)-(n).

The Institute for Population Health, Inc. (IPH) health center and many/all of its providers are deemed federal employees, with resultant coverage under the Federal Tort Claims Act (FTCA) for actions within the scope of deemed employment, pursuant to 42 U.S.C. 233(g)-(n). Accordingly, claims or notice of medical malpractice claims should be submitted by a claimant to the Office of General Counsel.
